Recommendation

Request the Board of Directors authorize the General Manager to execute the Amended and Restated Agreement for Purchase and Sale of Recycled Water and Related Facilities with County Sanitation District No. 2 of Los Angeles (CSD Contract No. 4340A) for \$642,891.00 effective July 1, 2024.

Background Information

Walnut Valley Water District (District) has been in negotiations with the Los Angeles County Sanitation Districts (San District) to acquire the remaining portion of the North Side Line between the Pomona Reclamation Plant (Plant) and the pressure-sustaining valve located along the pipeline alignment in Valley Boulevard near the entrance to the Spadra Landfill, known as the Upper Portion. The portion of the pipeline between the pressure-sustaining valve in Valley Boulevard and the District's J.P. Bourdet pump station is currently owned and maintained by the District, pursuant to the terms of the original agreement for the sale of recycled water from the Plant dated November 14, 2007. This Amended and Restated Agreement seeks to transfer the remaining portion of the pipeline to the District and settle the credit owed to the District for previous repairs and replacements performed on the pipeline. The remaining balance owed is based on the present value of the Upper Portion.

The District benefits and relies upon the gravity pipeline as its main source of supply to deliver its allocation of 3,360-acre feet per year from the Plant to the recycled water system. This Amended and Restated Agreement defines terms for the transfer of ownership, with a term of 25 years after the effective date. Funds for this project have been budgeted in the District's Capital Improvement Program and will be taken from appropriate reserves.
