Recommendation

The Board of Directors consider approval of the attached Negotiated Tax Exchange Resolutions Annexation of Tract 83534 to County Lighting Maintenance District 1687.

Background Information

The annexation process requires that a resolution for property tax revenue exchange be adopted by all the affected local agencies before an annexation can be approved. Under Section 95(m) of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, special districts providing new services to an area are entitled to a share of the annual tax increment generated in the area being annexed.

The District received a request from the County of Los Angeles Department of Public Works dated May 6, 2025, that the District participate in the exchange of ad valorem property tax in conjunction with the annexation of property into the County Lighting Maintenance District 1687 to provide revenue to partially fund the operation and maintenance of new street lighting services within the annexed territory. The boundary for this territory is shown on the attached proposed annexation map. For every \$100 received, the District would receive \$0.8255 and the County Lighting Maintenance District 1687 receiving \$0.0018.

Attached is the correspondence received from the County, including the two Joint Resolutions, a worksheet showing allocations, and maps of the areas being annexed. Please note that the District will not lose any existing ad valorem tax revenue it currently receives from the affected territory; it would only be giving up a portion of the revenues it would receive on increased assessed valuation.

NEGOTIATED TAX EXCHANGE RESOLUTION ANNEXATION OF TRACT 83534 TO COUNTY LIGHTING MAINTENANCE DISTRICT 1687

We request that the Walnut Valley Water District (WVWD) and Walnut Valley Water District Improvement District #5 (IMP DIST #5) participate in the exchange of ad valorem property tax in conjunction with the annexation of the territory known as Tract 83534 to County Lighting Maintenance District (CLMD) 1687. This proposed exchange would provide revenue to CLMD 1687 to partially fund the operation and maintenance of existing street lighting service. This territory, whose boundary is shown on the enclosed proposed annexation map, is being processed for the Board of Supervisors' concurrent approval of the annexation and transfer of ad valorem property tax between the affected taxing agencies and CLMD 1687.

For new annexations to a CLMD, our procedures require us to process the exchange of property tax revenues with all nonexempt taxing agencies. Under Section 99.01 of the California Revenue and Taxation Code, special districts providing new services to an area as a result of a jurisdictional change are entitled to a share of the annual tax increment generated in the area being annexed. CLMD 1687 meets the definition of a special district under Section 95(m) of the California Revenue and Taxation Code. CLMD 1687's share of the annual tax increment is to be taken from all of the other local taxing agencies providing services within the annexed area with the exception of school entities, which are exempted by law. If a taxing agency involved in the negotiation does not adopt a resolution providing for the exchange of property tax revenues, the Board can determine the exchange of property tax revenues for that taxing agency.

Enclosed is the Joint Resolution between Los Angeles County and the Walnut Valley Water District (approving and accepting the negotiated exchange of property tax revenue resulting from the annexation of the subject territory to CLMD 1687. Attached to the Joint Resolution, is a Property Tax Transfer Resolution Worksheet prepared for Tax Rate Area 08273 and 08366 listing the share of the annual tax increment to be exchanged with the Walnut Valley Water District, other affected taxing agencies, and CLMD 1687. The tax rate ratio(s) listed on the worksheet were calculated using a formula approved by the County Auditor-Controller and County Counsel. As shown on the Property Tax Transfer Resolution Worksheet for Tract 83534, the current and net tax share ratios for the Vector Control District and allocation to CLMD 1687 are summarized below.

Monetarily speaking, for TRA 08273, a \$10,000 increment in assessed valuation of a parcel means that the parcel will pay an additional \$100 in property taxes, of which the Walnut Valley Water District would receive \$0.8255 and CLMD 1687 would receive \$0.0018.

Request the Board of Directors:

- 1. Amend the award of contract to Resource Computer Solutions in the amount of \$566,866.92 for the District Headquarters IT, AV, Low Voltage and Security Services (P.N. 19-3569-1).
- 2. Award a contract to Axelliant in the amount of \$381,417.43 for Switches, Access Points (Wifi), Network Security, Firewalls, Routers, and Support Services.
- 3. Execute a Statement of Work with Axelliant for \$65,200 for the design and implementation of equipment related to the new administration building.
- 4. Authorize the General Manager to execute the contracts in a form acceptable to General Counsel.

Background

As part of the ongoing District Headquarters Remodel Phase 1 Project (Project), the District continues to make progress on key milestones.

The next step in the implementation of the project is the award of contracts for the installation and integration of IT infrastructure, audio/visual systems, low-voltage wiring, and security systems. Resource Computer Solutions and Axellient have been identified as the most qualified vendors to provide these services and have been working with the District's IT department, LCDG, and Searock to satisfy the needs of the Project.

The IT requirements for the Project involve two contractors. The contract awarded on April 21, 2025, pertained specifically to Resource Computer Solutions for the IT, AV, Low Voltage, and Security Services component. A separate contract is presented for the additional scope of work being performed by the District's IT Managed Services Provider, Axelliant. Axelliant will provide the required hardware, including new switches, access points, network security, firewalls, routers, and installation and support services. By contracting directly with Axelliant, the District saves on overhead costs compared to having RCS manage the entire project. In addition, our long-standing relationship with Axelliant and Cisco provides the potential for vendor discounts. If and when the District receives these credits, they will be debited from the project account.

In addition, it should be noted that the District is currently working with Congresswoman Linda Sanchez to obtain \$1.7M for the Emergency Operations Center and IT related components through the Community Funding Project. If the District is successful in obtaining these funds, they will offset the costs of these two contracts.

Funds for this project will be provided from the District Headquarters Remodel Capital Improvement Project. The contract agreement prepared by the District has been reviewed and approved by legal counsel.
